## **EXPERIENCE OF REFORMS IN POLAND FRANCE: CONCEPTUAL BASIS FOR DECENTRALISATION OF EXECUTIVE BODIES OF UKRAINE**

*At the present stage of the development of Ukraine as a democratic role, an important role is played by the introduction of a decentralization of power, which consists in the establishment of democratic governance, the transfer of authority to territorial authorities, ensuring the broad participation of citizens in the management of state and society as a whole, as well as the creation of a completely new Forms of executive bodies, which are intended to provide appropriate monitoring of local self-government, in order to effectively function.*

*The radical reform of state power, both at the level of local self-government bodies and at the level of state executive authorities, is not possible without revision of the basic legislative framework, amendments to the current legislation and the development and adoption of completely new legal acts that will become legislative basis for qualitative Implementation of public administration reform.*

*The paper analyzes the modern stage of reforming the administrative-territorial system of our state, which provides a significant expansion of the sphere of influence and competence in certain branches of local self-government bodies.*

*The reform of local self-government and the territorial organization of government should be carried out on the basis of the Constitution and laws of Ukraine, the provisions of the European Charter of Local Self-Government, with observance of the main European principles of democracy.*

*That is why the best example for reforming in Ukraine may be the experience of European countries regarding the implementation of the reform of a new distribution of powers between authorities. The most practical for Ukraine will be the use of experience in reforming executive bodies of the authorities and Poland.*

*The article presents a comparative table of powers of the future newly created body, such as prefect in Ukraine, as well as relevant powers of officials in European countries (Poland and France), is designed.*

*In the work, the influence of the newly formed authority for local self-government has been investigated.*
